Driver Education Parent/Guardian and Student Information

- 1. All tuition and fees must be current with the school's bursar in order to register.**
- 2. The cost for the spring semester is \$500.00, which must be paid by money order, made out to St. Joseph by-the-Sea High School. Personal checks will not be accepted. The deadline for payment is Friday, March 5th 2021.**
- 3. Students must be 16 years of age by Monday, March 15th 2021, in order to be eligible for registration.**

Phases of the Program

- 1. Part 1—"Behind the Wheel"—Hands-on experience with a certified driver education instructor.**
- 2. Part 2—"Learning the Laws"—Lecture class, studying the rules of the road, DWI, laws and consequences, and insurance information.**

Spring Program Dates: March 15th-June 30th

Rules for Students

- 1. Proper classroom behavior is required. All interactions with teachers and other students have the same expectations as a regular school day.**
- 2. Excessive absences would lead to removal from the program, and the registration fee would be non-refundable.**
- 3. Students are not permitted the use of cell phones or other electronic devices in the classroom for lecture or in the car for driving lessons.**

New York State Laws

- 1. Parents are not permitted to practice with students.**
- 2. The law states that you must have a dual brake vehicle and a driver education/driving school license in order to practice driving with an unlicensed/permit driver in all five boroughs.**
- 3. A New York permit is typically not recognized by other states.**
- 4. If you are 16 or 17 years of age, the following rules apply:**
 - a. Must possess a permit for a minimum of six months from the issue date in order to take the road test.**
 - b. Must possess the MV262 form with parent signature, which will be given to the student by the driving instructor.**
 - c. Must possess the MV285 form, which will be given to the student by the program director at the completion of the course.**

*****Please remember that driving is a privilege, not a right. Students must understand and appreciate this significant responsibility and must demonstrate a mature attitude at all times.**
